- 80 credits
  - Must be grade 10, 11, or 12 level courses
  - Each course is 4 credits
  - Totaling 20 courses
- 80 credits includes <u>required</u> courses and <u>elective</u> courses (a minimum of 4 courses (16 credits) at the Grade 12 level including English 12)
- Three Provincial Graduation Assessments:
  - Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment (GNA 10)
  - Grade 10 Literacy Assessment (GLA 10)
  - Grade 12 Literary Assessment (GLA 12)
- <u>New Indigenous Education Requirement</u> all students will be required to complete this new requirement beginning next year.


